In this **resources folder** you will find a downloadable template and sample ideas for working with other subjects to produce co-operative projects culminating in presentations, discussions, debates, posters, power point presentations etc.

Each document contains two grids, which can be filled in, as per the sample:

1. ✓ Potential Links:

This document is intended as a tool to allow teachers/leaders to identify potential links with other subjects quickly, by ticking where they feel a potential link could occur.

2. Planned activities:

This document is intended to be used subsequently to enable discussion around planning and identify planned activities.
